The Members page is a forum which enables *Wheelrights* members communicate with one another. Any site visitor can view the posts but only members can post them. To do this they need to register. This requires a (forum) name and a password.

The Members page (members.htm) uses the files named in the boxes above. They involve html, php and MySQL code, MySQL to store the data in a database. This is organised in tables: *themes* with two columns, an id and theme description, with a row for each theme; *namepass* with name and password in two columns, with a row for each contributor; and *posts* with separate columns for a link to the post's theme id, author, date and post content, with a row for each post.

Registered users will be able to submit posts without them being vetted. However, they are advised that posting on this forum is on the understanding that your post is consistent with Wheelrights objectives and does not comprise commercial advertising. If it is subsequently found that a post violates this understanding then the organisers reserve the right to delete it
