General Comments

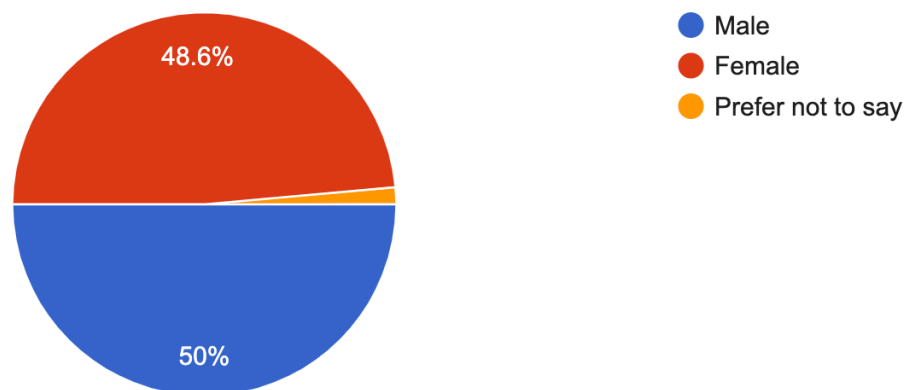
- 70 Respondents (38 online/32 paper form)

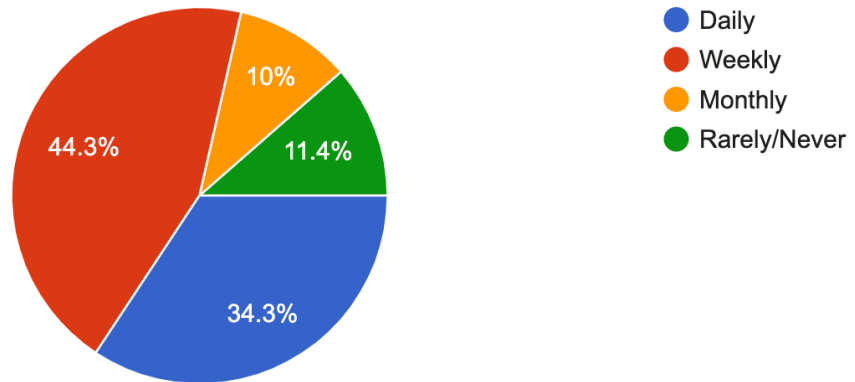
70 responses

How often do you cycle?

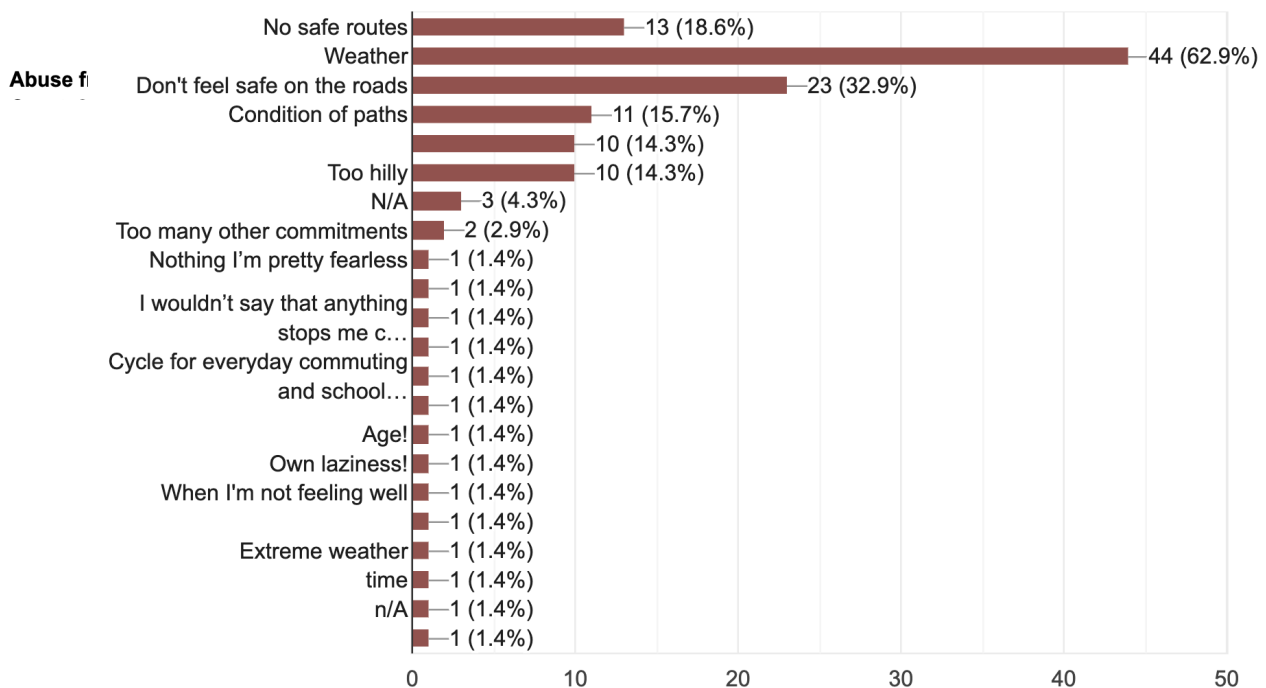
70 responses

What stops you from cycling ? Tick all that apply

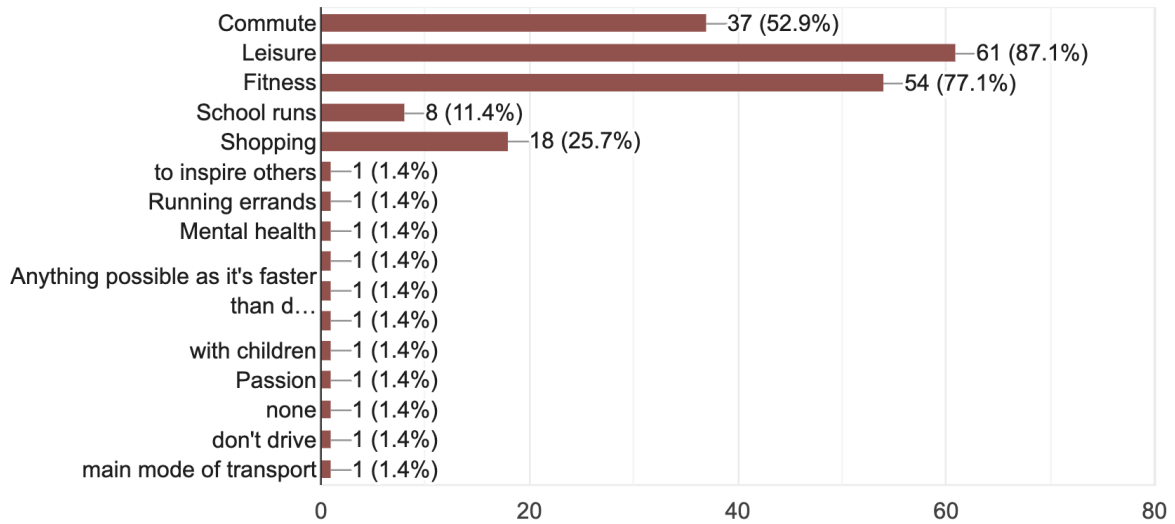

Why do you cycle? Tick all that apply

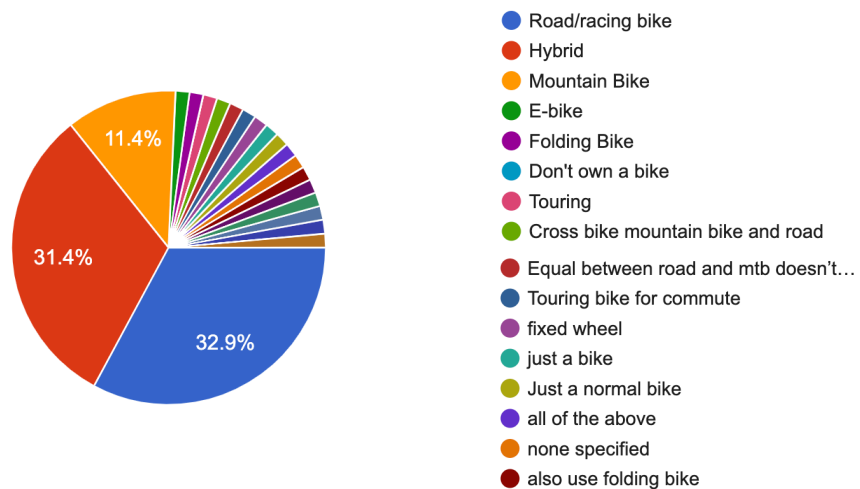

- People had chance to specify exactly what they had and took the opportunity!

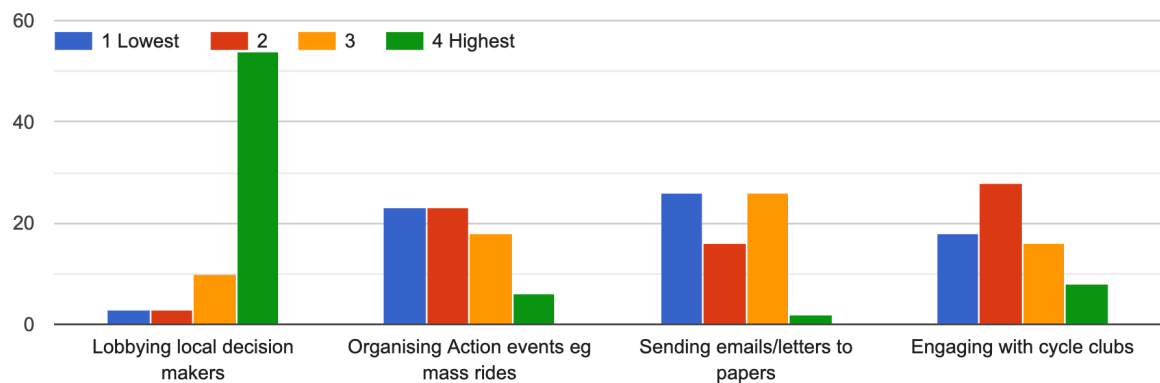
What type of bike do you normally use?
